

TESTING

Our hot Aussie summers can see

temperatures above 40degrees C and cold winters often reaching temperatures of zero. When we leave a locked car in the sun for just an hour in summer or winter the temperature soars, often exaggerated in the confined space way beyond normal readings outside the vehicle. Solarscreens placed on the windows certainly help to reflect the sun and reduces the heat build up inside. Having travelled with Solarscreens now for more than 6 months on my vehicle I'm happy to say they have performed better than expected. During summer



the vehicle was certainly much more comfortable to climb into and one could hold the steering wheel without searing the palms of your hands. Temperatures recorded during summer were a good 10+degrees C cooler inside the car compared to the outside temp after the screens had been up for about an hour. The winter months have also seen some benefits as the vehicle has not been as cold internally and the need to run the heater on maximum setting has not been necessary because the warmth was trapped and not lost through the glass. The screens are made of 7 layers consisting of a dense aluminum, polyethylene, anti-allergic Dacron padding and anti-condensate PVC film all quilted together.

The combination of these properties blocks out infra red, ultra violet and visible light from the vehicle providing the best possible insulation. The density of the screens prevents further sun damage to the interior and accessories, while being 100% reflective and lightweight.

Solarscreens are measured to fit any shape or size window internally on your vehicle, boat, caravan or home, have fully bound edges and adhere using simple suction cup disks onto the glass making removal effortless at any time. Privacy and security is another major advantage as not only can you sleep comfortably in your vehicle without condensation forming on the inside, the contents of your car, boat or caravan is no longer visible to prying eyes. This has to be a plus these days with our accessories and camping contents often worth as much as the vehicle for
